

GENERATION GAP – Fun Class

Grab a friend, parent, trainer, and get entered!!!!

- ◆ You may choose which rider goes first.
 - ◆ Both riders will ride the same horse. (*See exception below*)
 - ◆ Riders must be a minimum of 10 years apart in age.
 - ◆ One Youth rider (U19 as of January 1st current year) plus One Adult rider!
 - ◆ Can ride English or Western. Can both ride the same seat or different.
 - ◆ Just bring your tack and be ready to switch in the changeover box if changing.
 - ◆ Trail obstacles included in both halves. Walk/Jog pattern.
 - ◆ 1st rider rides first half of the pattern then enters and halts in the changeover box, switch riders, 2nd rider rides second half of the pattern
 - ◆ There will be a mounting block in the changeover box.
 - ◆ Both riders scores are combined to give an overall team score.
 - ◆ Teams may co-ordinate outfits if desired!
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***Exception:** Small Fry (U9) and exhibitors competing on the lead may use their own pony if it is under 13.2hh

The "One-Horse" Generation Class Rule

The Core Rule (Same Horse): Teams must use the exact same horse for both halves of the pattern. The adult and youth must complete the changeover in the box.

The Strict Pony Exception (Under 13.2hh): An exception to the "same horse" rule is granted only for Small Fry and Lead line riders (ages 9 and under) riding a genuine pony under 13.2 hands (138 cm).

If a pony under 13.2hh is used, the child may ride the pony, and the adult partner may ride a separate, standard-sized horse.

The "Horse" Clause; If the child is riding a *horse* 13.2 hands or over and that animal is deemed large enough for an adult; therefore, the adult and child can share that exact horse.
